TULARE COUNTY FAIR SEEKS FAIR ENTRIES FOR 2007 PARADE

TULARE – The Tulare County Fair is accepting entries for its 2007 opening day parade.

The Tulare County Fair is asking for the submission of floats, vintage cars and trucks, marching bands, youth groups, military, majorettes, drill teams, and other groups to enter the parade. There is no cost to enter the parade, which is scheduled to begin at 10 a.m., on Wednesday, Sept. 12 at Salida Street and Tulare Avenue in Tulare. The parade will end at the Tulare County Fairgrounds where the run of the 2007 Fair will kick off with “Kids Day,” when children 12 and under are admitted free.

“This is a chance for the entire county to come together and show countywide pride at our fair,” said Susie Godfrey, Tulare County Fair Interim General Manager. “We hope everyone comes out to celebrate what makes Tulare County a great place to live.”

Parade entry forms are available at the Fair’s Administration Office at 215 Martin Luther King Jr. Ave. and must be turned in by Aug. 24.

Tulare County residents will begin “Harvesting Countywide Pride” Sept. 12-16 at the 2007 Tulare County Fair. The fair will be open from 11 a.m. to midnight on Wednesday, Sept. 12; 4 p.m. to midnight on Thursday, Sept. 13; and 12 p.m. to midnight Friday, Sept. 14 through Sunday, Sept. 16. Admission is \$7 for adults, \$4 for children 6-12 years of age and people ages 62 and older. Children age 5 and under are admitted for free.
