

JUNIOR LIVESTOCK DEPARTMENT

MARKET GOATS

ENTRY FORMS DUE BY 6:00 PM, AUGUST 28, 2009

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per Entry

1. Market Goats may not be entered in the Dairy or Pygmy Goat Division.
2. Market Goats must be 70 to 120 lbs. in weight and not more than 10 months of age. Exhibitors showing and selling goats weighing over 120 lbs. will only be paid up to 120 lbs.
3. Qualifying Market Goats are eligible for the Junior Livestock Auction. Exhibitors are allowed to sell one (1) market animal. Should the exhibitor of the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion also have another market animal, they can sell **only** the Market Goat.
4. Male goats must be neutered and all goats must be debudded.
5. Fairs will not accept goats from scrapie "non-compliant" flocks, or animals that are scrapie-positive or scrapie suspects. All market goats must have a scrapie tag in order to be weighed.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for their market goat, until Sunday evening, September 20. Release for market is Monday morning.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR

Pre-Entry Not Required

1. A Premier Exhibitor will be selected from both the FFA and 4-H Divisions of Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Sheep and Swine.
2. One Premier Exhibitor will be selected for the Dairy Goats and Pygmy Goats.
3. Points will be tallied per the following system on a **MAXIMUM** of the 5 highest placing animals per exhibitor. Only one (1) champion placing point (highest) will be used per animal. Sixth animal will be used as tiebreaker. If neither exhibitor has 6 animals, then showmanship placing will be used. (Market Ready = 3 points, 1st place = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points and 5th = 1 point, Jr / Sr Champion = 1 point, Champion = 2 points, Grand Champion = 3 points).
4. Points will be given for placement in a showmanship class. If an exhibitor advances from a Novice class and places in that class, points given will be based on the highest placement.
5. Exhibitors having received a RED TAG for untidy pens or stalls will not be considered for this award.
