1. Only students enrolled in a Tulare County School, in grades Preschool-12th grade, can participate in Divisions 317-322.
2. Students entering a school project through their school/teacher can only enter their projects in Divisions 317-322.
3. A separate school entry form is attached in the back of the book. Please fill the entry form out with the necessary information, and an email will be sent to you, requesting your class list and information.
4. Exhibitors will only be awarded two premiums in divisions 317-322.
5. Enter the division that corresponds with the grade of the exhibitor at the time the entry was produced.
6. Drawings MUST be mounted on construction paper with a minimum of 2" border.
7. Group projects are limited to 1 per teacher in each division 323-325.
8. A group project is any project that ten or more students work together to produce. EXAMPLE: A third grade classroom has all made a crayon drawing. If all the drawings are single sheets and are not attached together, they would all be entered in the individual students names in Division 317-322. If all those drawings were connected together in a "mural," it would be entered as a group project under the teacher's name in Division 323. **Group Projects See Division 323.**

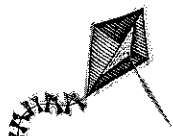
